

## High Point Pool Policy on Private Parties

High Point Pool welcomes parties sponsored by members. The rules below have been adopted by the board to ensure fairness to all members and to assist the management of the pool. The pool staff will make every attempt to comply with these rules so that all members may enjoy the facilities equally.

1. Parties must be scheduled at least one week in advanced by an adult member of the pool. The pool manager keeps a master calendar at the front desk. You may schedule parties with the pool manager. The pool manager has final approval for scheduling. Payment must be made at the time of reservation.
2. Only official pool functions may be scheduled on holidays i.e. 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Opening weekend. Absolutely NO parties are to be scheduled on raft nights, check main calendar for schedule.
3. Parties may be scheduled for either under the main awning, on the terrace, or the picnic area.
4. For children's parties, which include non-member children, the pool manager will require that attendees listen to a review of pool safety rules and etiquette. An attending adult must sign that he/she understands the rules and must remain present at the party. For children under the age of 10 an appropriate adult to child ratio must also be present at the party. Two adults to every ten children is required. 7 or more non member guests is considered a party.
5. The charge for parties is for up to twenty swimmers with a maximum party size of twenty-five. Any more than said amount of twenty five needs board approval. These fees ensure the appropriate amount of staff are scheduled on duty during party hours. Payment must be made at the time of reservation. Party fees are:  
Weekdays Monday through Friday at 5:59PM \$75.  
Weekends and Holidays Friday after 6:00PM Saturday and Sundays \$100.
6. Parties are limited to three hours each. No more than one party may be scheduled at a time for any one specific area.
7. The sponsor shall pick up all trash and décor and put into the proper trash bins and return all furniture to its proper place.
8. Party sponsors are responsible for the safety and welfare of their guests. Guests are expected to comply with the rules of the Pool, and the manager on duty may halt a party at his/her discretion if the guest behavior is not compatible with the rules.
9. Swim tests will be administered by lifeguards for all non-member children and children under the age of 12. Wristbands will note qualification level of swimmer. **NO PARENT MAY LEAVE WITHOUT THEIR CHILD PASSING SWIM TEST!** Guests may not allow parents to drop off until proper permission from lifeguard on duty is granted.
10. Grill usage is on a first come first serve basis. If you want to RESERVE the grill a \$20 deposit fee is required.
